Triumph began with 16 individuals seeking services in Birmingham. Triumph has grown rapidly since its opening, supporting more than 500 individuals in developing and achieving their goals for independence. Triumph opened its first satellite office in Montgomery in July 2016 with plans to have offices across the state.
